Treasurer's Report:

Income for August 2008 was \$270 with expenses of \$158.16. The Association's account
balance as of the end of August is \$28,168.61.

As per the Board's directive, Monarcha Marcet reported that \$13,000 of the Association's
funds have been placed in a money market account and \$10,000 has been placed in a seven
month certificate of deposit.

President's Report:

David Rose reported that it is time to form a nominating committee to recommend board
members and officers for 2009. The appointed committee members are Cleave Frink
(chair), Miles Hardy, Bruce Thomas and Eben Self.

Old Business:

Edgewater Drive Vision Task Force:

Bob Carr reported that the Edgewater Drive Vision Task Force met on August 21 at city
hall to review the suggestions and recommendation identified by the Task Force.
Generally, the topics center on 'community friendly growth management'.

New Business & Committee Reports:

Website Committee:

Adrian La Sala reported on several aspects of the new website and the annual CPNA
newsletter.

After a lively discussion on how the effectiveness of the newsletter might be measured, it
was decided to pay the extra price to produce the newsletter in full color.

Motion: The Board agreed to introduce 'Café Press' to the website. With no startup,

maintenance, or overhead expenses to the Association, web users can order merchandise containing CPNA's logo. The Association receives a share of the funds collected by Café Press.

The new website allows for public forums and it the Board agreed to introduce the Forums feature on the website so that 'hot' topics may be discussed online.

The new website has a tool for a 'Photo Find' feature so that the public can search the CPNA website for pictures of events or use key words association with the photo.

Crime Committee:
