College Park's Historic Homes Tour November 20th

The 15th annual Historic Homes Tour will be Sunday, November 20, from 12:30 to 5:00 p.m., in the Adair Park/Ivanhoe area of College Park.

The tour is a benefit of College Park Neighborhood Association membership. It is a tour about the architecture and history of College Park. This year's tour particularly emphasizes historic preservation and successful rehab. At least seven of the tour homes will be open for visitation.

Each year the proceeds from the tour are presented as the Michael Welborn Education Grant to one of our local schools; we hope to clear at least \$500. Edgewater is the school chosen for this year. In the past, a number of Edgewater students have been volunteers at tour homes, and we are looking forward to Edgewater involvement for this tour as well. This year we expect to have special history handouts for the house

volunteers, in addition to the tour brochures that serve as tickets.

This year more than ever we want to emphasize that this is primarily YOUR tour – a tour for and about College Park. We urge you to set aside a couple of hours November 20 to volunteer and/or attend. Princeton Students Assist Hurricane Victims

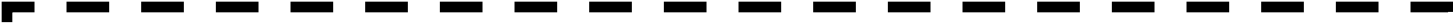
